On January 20th, 2017, over 200 people were mass arrested for protesting the inauguration of Donald Trump. In a shocking display of state repression, prosecutors charged the protesters with multiple felony charges including "rioting" and "conspiracy to riot." By standing together, refusing plea deals, and courageously taking their cases to trial, J20 defendants have been pushing back. The prosecutor's case has fallen apart: since the first trial, over 130 people have been acquitted or had all charges dismissed. But the fight is far from over 59 people are still facing decades in prison.
