Patriot Prayer, a white nationalist group on the West Coast, has called for two rallies, one in Portland on **August 4th** and another in Berkeley on **August 5th**. This caravan is attempting to build ground support for the national fascist rally "Unite the Right 2" in Washington, DC on **August 12th**.

It's up to us to halt their march! Friends in Portland and Berkeley are going up against another white nationalist threat. Together, in DC we can shut it down.

At last year's "Unite the Right" rally, hundreds of Alt-Right nationalists flooded into the streets of Charlottesville. That day their hateful ideology culminated in a fascist driving his car into the counter-protest, killing **Heather Heyer** in the street and injuring dozens of other people.

This year, the Alt-Right is taking its violent ideology on a nationwide tour.

It's no surprise that the final stop is the front of the White House at Lafayette Square the center of white supremacy, settler colonialism, and racist terror. Trump is the white nationalists' President. While ICE separates children from their parents at the border, Patriot Prayer, Richard Spencer, and the Proud Boys hold anti-immigrant rallies. In 2017, Sean Urbanski, a member of the Facebook group "Alt Reich: Nation," killed Bowie State student Richard Collins III. A year after Trump was elected, Casa Ruby windows were smashed in the middle of the night. More recently, MPD's Gun Recovery Unit was caught wearing white nationalist symbols to courts, and every day suburban police departments with connections to anti-immigrant organizations cooperate with ICE. In the Maryland suburbs, the incel Jarrod W. Ramos murdered five Gazette journalists in Annapolis, and Austin Rollins killed several high school classmates. Their hateful movement will continue to spill blood until we make it stop.

If hate can bring out hundreds this August, we can unite in the thousands to stop them.

Crowd the streets to stop the hate tour in its tracks! Let's show the Alt-Right that they are not welcome, and that racism and anti-immigrant violence will not be tolerated in any city.
